**Prayer** is the vertical axis and it helps us strengthen our relationship with God.

**Almsgiving** is the horizontal axis and leads us to deepen are relations to our neighbors, especially the ones in need. Fasting is the interior axis and it leads us to know and understand better ourselves and our dependence on God.
