St. Mary's parishioner sets world record for most blood donations

Josephine Michaluk from Penhold, has donated 209 units of blood throughout her life, setting the world record for most donations by a woman.

Josephine started donating in 1965. She was visiting her older sister who had a blood donation appointment and was asked to come along. "I decided I would join her and that was the beginning," says Josephine as per the **Guinness World Record** official website.

Despite being in her 80s, Josephine gives one unit of blood four times a year.

On why she does what she does, Josephine says, "I feel like I have it in me to give. I can share it to people that need it."

She wants people to know there is such a high demand for blood to save lives and more people should be doing it.

On how she feels about breaking a record that she never set out to create, Josephine says, "I never even thought I would have a record; I was not donating for that reason. And I plan on

keeping on."


